Our fuel bill is astronomical at almost \$5 a gallon. We continue to struggle in keeping our doors open so any extra \$ you can send, we are grateful and if you know of anyone that has an exterior door or two they can donate, I believe they are 36" and need to swing to the left from the outside in, we have a great handyman that does our work at a reasonable rate. These are not covered by the insurance due to the deductible.

Our flag pole got hit and snapped at the base, sorry to say no one reported it so we are stuck with the cost to replace it. I with the help of our handyman have it jerry-rigged it for the moment to be able to use it. It's aluminum, if you know of a way to repair it please email us.

Thankfully our insurance covered our main building roof leak but then the cost of the insurance went up as it always does after a repair.

My apologies for the two in one newsletter, I fell behind and felt this was the best way to catch up. It also saves on the cost of mailing.

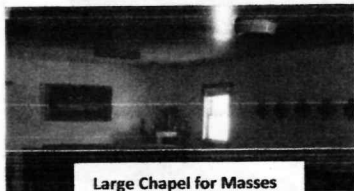
We can accommodate up to 7+ individuals overnight and 25-30 for day groups. We look forward to seeing your group this year!

The House is a hidden treasure in the foothills of the Adirondacks, that we pray will continue to attract lots of people for many years to come.

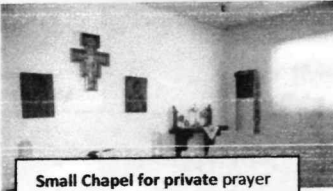
All is done by free will donations which help us keep our mission alive and the House of Prayer open.
